The following is extracted from a letter of AMC letter file 1032C-3 (CQC) dated 14 Aug/56.

- (a) The age limit of 4 querters stated in para 3.8 of MIL-H-55llA applies to hose and to hose assemblies supplied by hose manufactureres or hose couplers or their agents.
- (b) The age limits of MS 28741 apply to hose assemblies supplied to any government service by aircraft, engine or accessory manufacturers, or repair contractors. Therefore, assemblies from these sources are acceptable if the hose is not over 6 quarters old.

This is a clarification of the conflict between the age limit clauses of specification MIL-H-5511 and drawing MS28741.
