REPAIR AND OVERHAUL INSTRUCTIONS

NACELLE BULKHEAD ATTACHMENT BRACKET REPAIR SCHEME

INTRODUCTION

The attachment brackets securing the bulkhead at Sta. 104 to the main spar frame have been found with the weld fractured. A repair scheme, applicable to both the port and starboard nacelles, has been devised to enable local repairs to be carried out.

INSTRUCTIONS

- The following information is applicable to the repair of one broken bracket but is typical for any one of the three locations:
- (a) Remove the portion of the original bracket attached to the bulkhead.
- (b) Fabricate the required bracket in conjunction with the aircraft structure at the required location.
- (c) If a filler block is required as shown in Figure 3, fabricate to correct thickness to fit the aircraft.




Figure 1 View Looking Aft in Nacelle




Figure 2 Upper Bracket

- (d) Position and install the brackets, and spacers, if required, as shown in Figures 1, 2 or 3, as applicable.




Figure 3 Lower Brackets
