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


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Goodyear Main Landing Gear Brake Assemblies Removal of Brake Discs on Return to R & O

INTRODUCTION

MATCOM has previously authorized units by message to return certain Goodyear brake assemblies (less discs) to R and O. However, numerous reports have been received of discrepant brake receipts, which in some cases have resulted in discrepancy reports being raised on the offending units. This leaflet is intended to provide a more reliable and permenent directive for units involved with returning Goodyear brake assemblies for overhaul.

PURPOSE

This policy was implemented to reduce the weight involved when returning certain complete brake assemblies, as compared to the weight of those same assemblies when the discs have been removed. This is especially so with the large and exceedingly heavy disc used on the Hercules brake assembly Part 9550071 and the dual discs used on the T33 brake assembly Part 9540726. Implementation of this procedure has resulted in considerable saving in transportation costs. This policy is further supported by the fact that in many cases the removed brake discs have little or no repair capability or service life remaining.

PROCEDURE

- The following procedure is to be implemented when returning Goodyear brake assemblies Parts 9540726 and 9550071 for overhaul.
- (a) Remove the brake discs and assemble the brake assembly in accordance with relevant maintenance instructions, to prevent damage and loss of component parts during shipment.
- (b) Brake assembly less discs to be suitably tagged and returned identified by the RCAF Stock Number indicated in sub-paragraph (e).
- (c) Removed discs having service life remaining, are to be retained in Unit Brake Shop as maintenance spares and continued in service until all remaining life has been consumed. Removed unserviceable discs are to be reduced to produce.
- (d) Surplus brake discs (new and unused only) shall be brought on charge and returned to Unit Supply.

(e) Only the following brake assemblies listed by RCAF Stock Number (Col. "A") and Manufacturer's Part Number (Col. "B") are to be returned to the applicable R and O facility in accordance with Pamphlet 98, under the appropriate RCAF Stock and Part Numbers for brake assemblies less discs (Col. "C" and "D"). Aircraft applicability is included in Col. "E" for convenience. All other Goodyear main landing gear brake assemblies are to be returned to R and O as complete assemblies:

(f) Contractor overhaul procedure includes the installation of new discs and complete brake assemblies only will be returned to the relevant Supply Depots, under the appropriate RCAF Stock and Part Numbers. RCAF Stock and Part Numbers listed in Col. "C" and "D" above are used by units only when returning brake assemblies less discs for repair and overhaul. Units will normally demand and receive complete brake assemblies.
