FIRE EXTINGUISHER CYLINDERS REMOVAL FROM SERVICE

(This EO replaces Interim EO AFMI/M4/14 dated 31 Jul 42)

- l Fire extinguisher cylinders are to be removed from service when such cylinders are:-
- (a) Dented, nicked, scarred or otherwise damaged in any way so that local intensity of stress may be produced.
- (b) Subjected to heat of an intensity likely to affect the original heat treatment of the cylinder.
- (c) Discharged by exposure to heat.
- (d) Cylinders must not be clamped in vises or other devices which will mark or tend to distort them.
- 2 Equipment becoming surplus by this EO is to be disposed of in accordance with CAP 16, Vol. 1, Q13/2.
